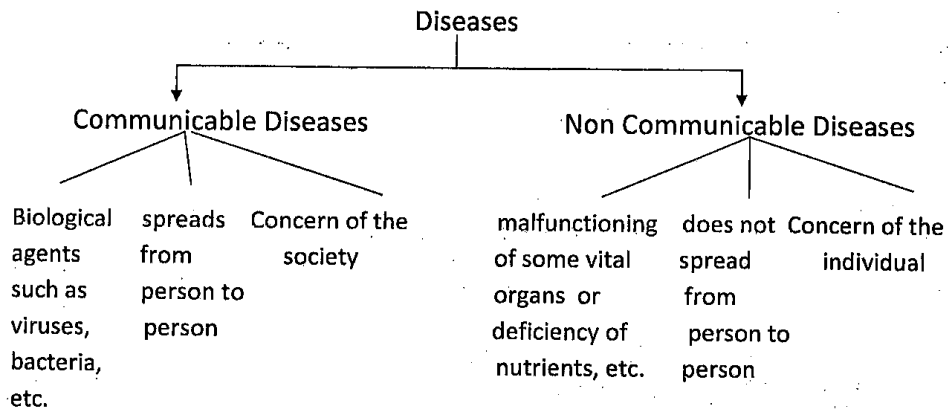

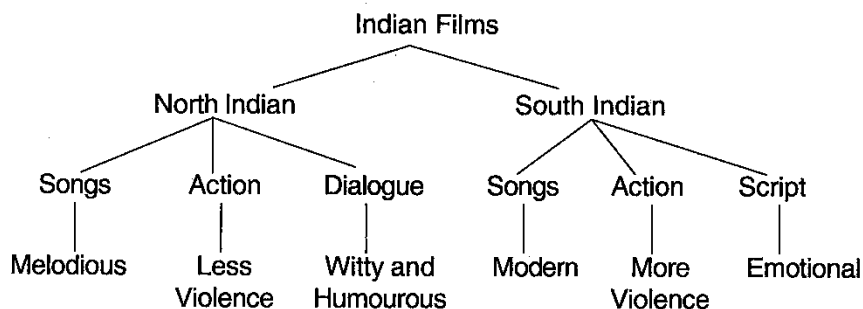
- 1) Freedom, sometimes will land people in trouble – substantiate with reference to the Goat of Monseieur Seguin.
